This firm recently took over the appeal of Mr. Embrey, whose probation was revoked on a stealing charge because he was unable to pay restitution. The Missouri Court of Appeals recently issued a decision in Mr. Embrey's favor, finding that it violated due process for a Court to revoke probation merely because the probationer cannot afford to make restitution payments. *State ex rel. Hawley v. Spear*, WD81140 (Mo. App. W.D. 2018). It is anticipated that Mr. Embrey will be released from prison in May of 2018 and will resume his probation.
